Formerly situated c400 yards west of the Church, UFFORD PLACE was built c1600, and in the 1620s was the home of the Hammond family, mentioned in C17 wills. In 1674 Mr. William Hamont and Mrs. Sara Hamont (sic) occupied houses specifically of 6 and 7 hearths, one of which was possibly the Place. After various rebuildings full documentation started in C18 and early C19. I.J. 1788, 1812, 1828. (Brooke maps, IRO/40/80/1/1 et seq.)
1844 W.D. UFFORD PLACE, F.C. Brooke Esq. A handsome mansion with pleasant grounds, formerly the seat of the Hammonds.
