## 26. Malthouse Farm

This is a typical Suffolk farmstead laid out in a regular U-plan with additional detached buildings. The farmhouse itself is detached and set away from the yard; the malthouse was built in the early C19<sup>th</sup> and is Flemish bond brick with a pantile roof.

Some of the working buildings have been lost. A recently demolished part of this house was once used for making malt from the farmer's barley which he used to brew his own small beer.
