



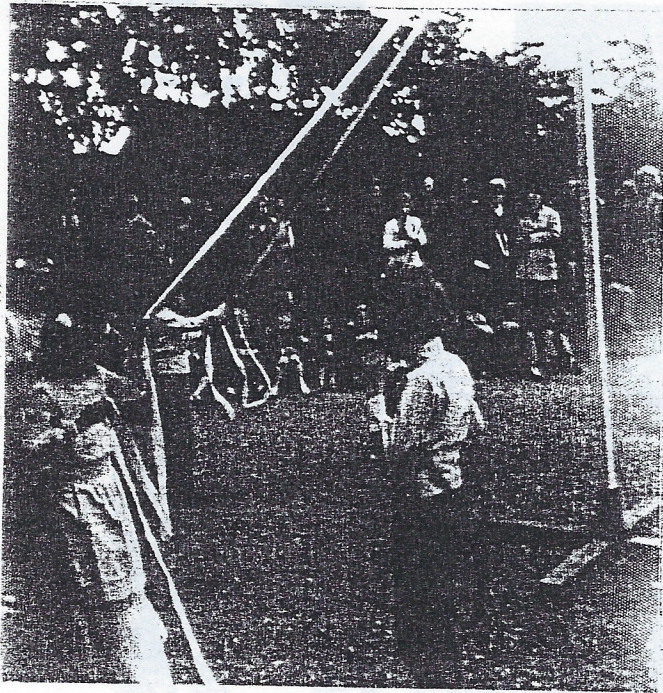

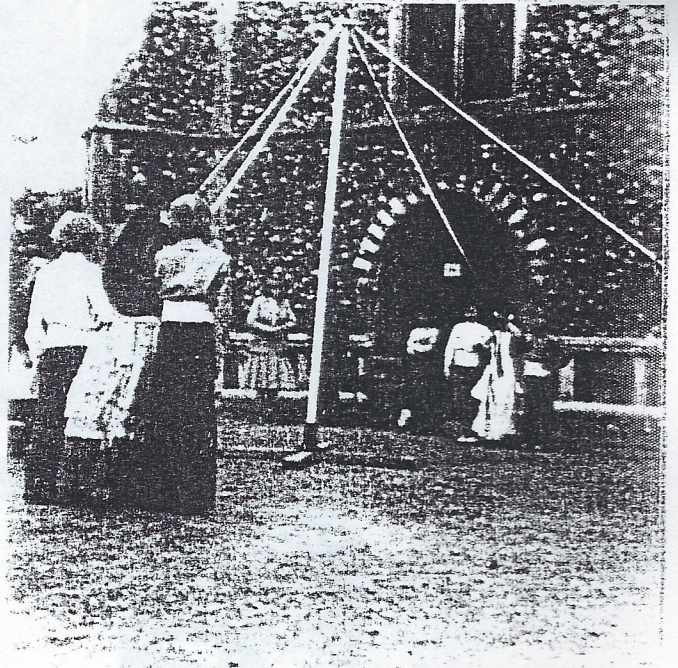

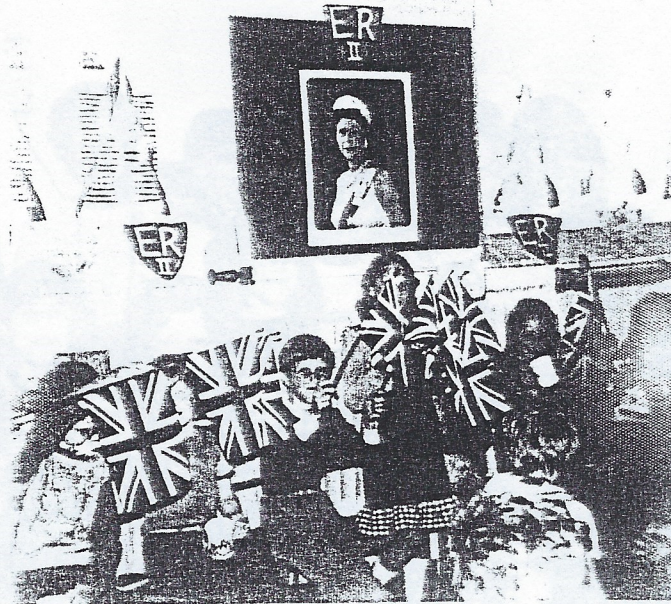

SCHOOL MAKES HISTORY

YOUNGSTERS from Ufford yesterday buried a time-capsule to mark the closure of their school.

Ufford School's 114-year history comes to an end today, and next term the pupils, aged between five and ten, will go to other schools in the area.

Among the items the children decided to preserve for

future generations was a copy of the Evening Star, a tape recording of the pupils' playground songs, and examples of their school books.

Headmaster Mr Aldous helped the youngsters bury the capsule and also plant an oak tree in Ufford church's graveyard.
